HUME CONFERENCE: In 1976, the bicentenary year of the death of David Hume, a Hume Conference will be held at the University of Edinburgh from 9th to 14th August. The major subject of papers and seminars will be Hume's philosophy but attention will also be paid to his historical and other interests.
