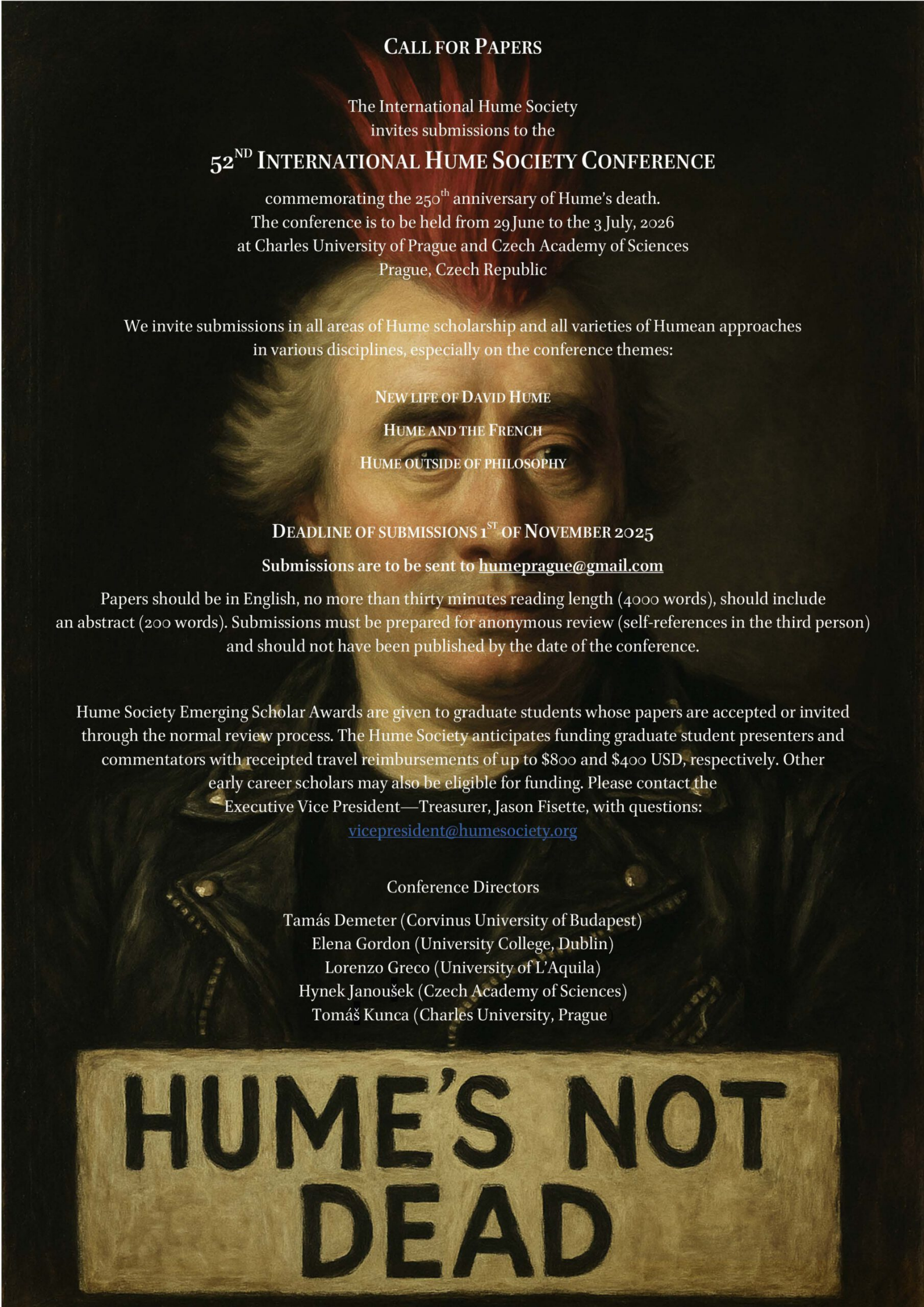

Papers should be in English, no more than thirty minutes reading length (4000 words), should include an abstract (200 words). Submissions must be prepared for anonymous review (self-references in the third person) and should not have been published by the date of the conference.

Hume Society Emerging Scholar Awards are given to graduate students whose papers are accepted or invited through the normal review process. The Hume Society anticipates funding graduate student presenters and commentators with receipted travel reimbursements of up to \$800 and \$400 USD, respectively.
